

NEW CONNECTION FEES - WATER

New or upsized connections to the Silver Lake Water & Sewer District's (District) system are assessed a General Facility Charge and an installation and permit fee. General Capital Facility Charges pay for capital improvements in the District. New water General Facility Charges are assessed per meter size or by the number of dwelling units as adopted by Resolution No. 674.

Customers may provide the District with a building permit issued prior to December 30, 2011, to be assessed the previous General Facility Charge under Resolution No. 651.

New or upsized water connections may also be required to pay developer reimbursements, system development fees, ULID assessments, or other fees depending on the property location.

Customers can request the District tap the water line, install the water service line, and construct the meter setter by contacting Ron Berger. The tapping, installation and construction will be billed on a time and material basis and must be paid prior to or with the new connection fees.
