NEW WATER CONNECTION FEES

Effective January 1, 2021

New or upsized connections to the Silver Lake Water and Sewer District's (District) system are assessed a General Facility Charge when connecting to the District's system to pay for capital improvements. The connection charges are assessed per meter size or number of dwelling units as adopted by Resolution No. 802.

Customers can apply for a new or upsized water connection by submitting a new permit application, which can be found at: https://www.slwsd.com/forms.html.

If a new water service line is needed, customers can request the District tap the water main and install the water service line. The tapping and service line installation will be billed on a time and material basis and must be paid prior to or with the new connection fees.
