Utility Maintenance Worker Apprenticeship Program

Annual Salary Range: \$62,424 – \$91,471 for a two year limited term / full time position

This Apprenticeship Program position involves 4,000 hours of paid on-the-job training along with 288 hours of paid formal training over a two-year period. Upon successful completion of the program, the candidate will be fully qualified in multiple aspects of water and wastewater operations.

Typical Tasks:

Work tasks generally include but are not limited to:

- Installs, repairs, and maintains water system components.
- Operates vehicles, small tools, and equipment.
- Repairs street curbs, streets, and sidewalks cut during system component installation or repair.
- Locates water and sewer mains, manholes, water services and side sewers; inspects newly installed water and sewer services; raises and/or repairs related components.
- Services and maintains small tools and equipment.
- Provides traffic control (flagging) as required.
- Processes work orders and assists in final project inspections.
- Reads water meters; verifies re-reads, checks for leaks, informs customers of high consumption.

Qualifications:

- Required: High School Diploma or GED.
- Required: Valid Washington state driver's license; acceptable driving record; and own transportation to/from the job.
